Research has proven that discursive political reality is of different nature than that of institutions and actions. The post-modern experience that in the world of politics everything is subject to rivalling interpretations has been justified. Research has discovered the fundamental conceptual and methodological categories of discursive political reality: the concept of categorisation and distinction, the intensity criterion and the exception and borderline definition. Empirical studies and receptions were carried out, which demonstrated the characteristics of particular parts of discursive political reality through the analysis of the language of enemy constructions, public welfare and talking politics.
